Getting Medical Assistance

Consultation Rates

IAMAT members can expect to pay up to the maximum amount on the rates listed below for the first consultation provided by private practice doctors. These rates do not apply to hospitals and clinics which will charge IAMAT members their standard consultation fees.

- Regular office/clinic calls US \$100
- House/hotel calls
 US \$150
- Night calls (from 9 pm to 9 am) US \$170
- Sundays and local holidays US \$170

These fees do not apply to laboratory procedures such as blood tests, ECGs, X-rays, surgical procedures, hospitalization, or any other expenses incurred.

We make every effort to keep the Medical Directory listings updated. IAMAT members can access the latest updates online at www.iamat.org.

Qualifications and Medical Services

Our doctors are fully licensed in their own country and are fluent in English. They also agree to care for travellers based on IAMAT's set consultation rates.

IAMAT doctors can make referrals, report to your own doctor and provide a medical report if required.

The privileges of your IAMAT membership are not in effect when travelling in your own country since your local medical association will be of assistance.

Contacting IAMAT Doctors

Contact the participating IAMAT clinic in your area to make an appointment. Phone numbers, emails, websites and mobile numbers are provided. Present your IAMAT Membership Card prior to the consultation and pay the doctor directly at the time of service.

IAMAT is continuously inspecting affiliated clinics to ensure that travellers receive the highest standard of medical care available.
